News from the Scientific Program Committee



Dear Colleagues and Friends,

EuroMedLab Athens 2017 will be accompanied by four Satellite Meetings to be staged before and after the main congress. These events will cover the scientific areas of inborn errors of metabolism, metabolic bone disease, diabetes and advances in Laboratory Medicine and Pathobiology.

All four Satellite Organizing Committees, as you can see in the following pages, have been working hard preparing a program of scientific excellence that will excite and inform the European and International community of laboratory Medicine and related specialties.

The venue of each symposium was chosen to highlight a part of the history of Greece.

Thus, the first pre-congress Satellite Meeting on "Inborn Errors of Metabolism" will take place from June 10th to 11th, in the amphitheatre of one of the most historical Hospitals in Greece, the Children's Hospital "Aghia Sophia". The hospital was founded in 1896 and became operational in 1901. It is the largest pediatric hospitals in the country and one of the largest pediatric hospitals in Europe.

The venue of the second pre-congress meeting on "Metabolic Bone Disease", on June 10th will also be held in the centre of the city of Athens, in the Athens War Museum whose mission is to collect and preserve military artifacts and memorabilia, and to study and document the military history of Greece

from antiquity to the present day. The exhibits, from around the world, are dating from the Neolithic Age to the first half of the 20th century.

In the post congress schedule participants can follow, after the closing ceremony of the main congress, the satellite symposium on "Diabetes". The time frame of this meeting is from June 15th afternoon to June ¹⁶th and it will take place in the at Cape Sounio, where the horizon meets the Aegean Sea. The temple of Poseidon, the ancient Greek god of the sea, dominates the place from where participants will experience the famous sunset.

On June 16th, participants can travel by ferry or fly, where the fourth meeting "Advances in Laboratory Medicine and Pathobiology" is taking place, to Santorini, a memorial of the reformation of the land by the second largest volcanic eruption in recorded history and the creation of this picturesque beautiful island of the Aegean Sea.

We are looking forward to welcoming you in EuroMedLab Athens 2017.







How to get to Athens

Athens is easily accessed by air, sea and land (road and railroad) as it is the Greece's capital and one of the major cities of the Balkans and the Eastern Mediterranean area. Moreover, moving around the city is a real pleasure. Athens public transportation system connects the city center and Megaron - Athens International Conference Center, the Congress Venue, with all surrounding areas through a modern network combining many lines of metro, suburban railway, train, buses, trolleys and trams. 


